SUBJECT: 'C' League Schedule, July 5 to September 1

The schedule for the remainder of the 'C' League season is attached. The schedule for the second half begins on Tuesday, July 5, and it continues through Thursday, September 1. One new team (the traditional "Co-op" team) has been added to the league for the second half. This gives us an odd number of teams and causes one bye per week.

Thank you for your response to our request for game reports. Over half the managers took the time to fill them in. The new schedule reflects a slight reshuffling of team rankings based on the reports. Hopefully, there won't be many mismatches on the new schedule.

The schedule for the week of July 4 is essentially a rescheduling of the games that were rained out during the first week of the season. The rest of your team's second half schedule probably includes a few opponents repeated from the first half. You won't play anyone more than twice. This setup represents a compromise between two objectives: to let everyone play the maximum number of different opponents, and to let everyone play a lot of games against opponents they're evenly matched with.

Please note on the new schedule that the assignment of teams to equipment monitors has been changed (effective July 5). If your team is affected, make sure that you go to the right place to get the equipment.

Teams playing on field 'H3' always have the option to turn the field around by setting up home plate near the street intersection. This avoids sun problems for the batter. The two managers should discuss which orientation is preferable on a given day. In case of disagreement, the team that brings the equipment makes the selection.

All games are scheduled to start at 5:30 pm. This means that your team should arrive earlier than 5:30 to warm up. **You should have at least 10 players (including at least 3 women) ready to start playing at 5:30.** The managers' game reports show that a lot of teams have been neglecting this basic obligation. We don't want any more forfeits or interminably delayed games. If your team is an offender, you'd better shape up! (If your team's record is clean, keep up the good work!)
