SUBJECT: C League Schedule, July, August, and (possibly) September

A schedule is attached for C League games up to the first week in August. Note that there are no C League games scheduled during the entire Fourth of July week. Also notice that we have two new teams added to the league for the second-half schedule.

For games during the remainder of August and (possibly) the first week in September, you all get a chance to design your own custom schedules. Now's your chance to schedule the teams you really like to play, instead of the teams the schedulemaker tells you to play. Arrange your preferred games with the opposing managers, and return the attached form to **Sam Dolinar no later than Friday, July 6**. Make sure that you and your opposing managers **both** send in the same requests. If only one team requests a game, the request will be ignored. If you don't submit a full schedule of four or five requested games, the remainder of your schedule will be filled in randomly (unless you specifically request "NO GAME" for a given week).

If we receive credit from the City of Pasadena for our April rainouts, C League will have enough money to extend our season about one week past Labor Day. This will only be done if a substantial fraction of C League teams indicate (on the attached form) a desire to play games during Labor Day week.

A couple of C League teams might have the option to participate in the B Minor League double elimination playoff tournament during August. Two C League teams opted to enter this tournament last year in lieu of scheduling C League games during August. If you're interested, call the B Minor League Commissioner, Dan Leotta (4-1218), for details. You will be charged an extra fee if you want to play *both* B Minor League tournament games and regular C League games during August.

### Instructions

1. Contact the managers of the teams you would like to play during August and (possibly) the first week in September. Agree on a preferred week and day-of-week for the game.
2. No team may request more than one game per week. You may leave some weeks blank (no request), and a randomly selected game will be filled in for you, unless you specifically request "NO GAME" for a particular week.
3. Your requested game will be put on the official schedule, provided **both managers** submit the identical request (indicating mutual agreement). If only one team requests a game, the request will be ignored.
4. Your requested game will be scheduled during the week that you request, but possibly not on your preferred day-of-week. Day-of-week preferences will be honored on a first-come, first-served basis.
5. As requests come in, a master schedule sheet will be posted and updated on Sam Dolinar's office door (238-434). You can refer to this sheet or call Sam (4-7403) to find out which potential opponents are still available during a given week.
6. All forms must be received by **Sam Dolinar (Mail Stop 238-420)** no later than **Friday, July 6**, and the official schedule will be distributed within the following week. Unrequested games will be assigned randomly to fill out the schedule.
