SUBJECT: 'C' League Schedule, April 27 through July 2

Attached is the continuation of the 'C' League schedule through the Fourth of July weekend. Over two-thirds of the managers responding to our previous memo expressed a preference for establishing a new field 'H7' over having lots of byes per week. The new schedule uses 'H7' to maintain a full 14-game-per-week schedule.

No matter where you put it, 'H7' is a tight squeeze between existing fields 'H3' and 'H4'. The arrangement that gives the most room is indicated on the attached map. Home plate for 'H7' should be located approximately 240 to 260 feet from home plate of 'H4', approximately along the right field foul line of 'H4'. It should be moved off the foul line toward the street by 10 to 30 feet. The new field 'H7' should be aligned in the same direction as 'H4'.

Even with this "optimum" arrangement for 'H7', the distance from 'H7' to 'H3' is uncomfortably short. Approximately 50 feet of additional separation may be obtained by turning 'H3' around and playing 'H3' from the southwest corner of area 'H'. This arrangement also alleviates the sun problems of the standard 'H3' field. On the new schedule, games scheduled for 'H3' are identified as 'H3L'. Home plate for the field 'H3L' should be set up approximately 260 feet down the left field foul line of the standard 'H3'. Home plate should be positioned as close to the southwest corner of area 'H' as possible, approximately 50 to 70 feet from both streets. The right field foul line of 'H3L' should be skewed about 10° to 15° clockwise from the left field foul line of 'H3', so as to create a reasonable left field distance for 'H3L' before intersecting the street.

Users of all the fields 'H3L', 'H4', and 'H7' should constantly stay aware of their close neighbors and take precautions to avoid colliding with someone or being hit by a long ball. Please let us know if there are any problems with the suggested field arrangements. We realize that an "optimal" arrangement worked out on paper is not necessarily an optimal arrangement in practice.
