SUBJECT: Funding for the 'C' League Picnic

At last month's ERC Council meeting, the Council approved ERC funding of a picnic for 'C' League softball teams. The formula for the amount of ERC funding was set at \$3 for every \$1 ticket sold.

To this date, ERC has already advanced us an amount of \$289.50 to pay the City of Pasadena for reserving the Brookside Park picnic area on Sunday, September 13. This amount includes a refundable \$62 cleaning deposit. The remaining \$227.50 pays for a small picnic area (\$144.50) and two softball fields (\$83), on which we plan to conduct several organized activities for the picnic attendees.

The cost of the picnic area and softball fields represents a fixed expense which we are committed to pay regardless of the number of tickets sold. Therefore, we request that the Council approve a revised ERC funding formula to reflect this fixed cost. Specifically, we seek approval of a flat grant of \$227.50, plus an additional \$2.50 per \$1 ticket sold. The per-ticket subsidy of \$2.50 per person includes approximately \$2.00 for food and drinks and \$0.50 for prizes. We are estimating that the total cost of food and drinks will be about \$3.00 per person, of which \$1.00 will be covered directly by ticket sales.
